Training Program: Enhance Artists Creative Arsenal

From the end of February to the end of April, our selected artists will embark on a transformative journey through our comprehensive training program. Led by marine scientists, digital experts, and creative professionals, this program aims to elevate artists' skills in Ocean Literacy, Digital Technologies, and Innovative Sustainable Methods. The training, facilitated through an E-Learning platform developed by DAN Europe, is divided into three modules: Ocean Conservation and Climate Change, Sustainability, Technology.



What's next? The Residence Programme

Ustica, Alonissos, and Gozo will host artists in a unique blend of natural wonders, ancient maritime traditions, and immersive encounters with the local communities.

The **residence programme** will take place during the following periods:

- Alonissos: 7th – 17th May 2024
- Gozo: 3rd – 9th June 2024
- Ustica: 16th – 22nd September 2024

The project provides artistic mentoring with on-site support and online meetings with the ART4SEA artistic direction and experts.
